

How to arrive to Aveiro

From Francisco Sá Carneiro airport (Porto) to Aveiro

By train: The best way to arrive in Aveiro from this airport is by metro and then by train. You should take the metro (purple line) <<https://www.metrodoporto.pt>> until the station “Campanhã” (~30 min). There you should take a train to Aveiro (40-50 min) <<https://www.cp.pt/passageiros/pt>>. You must buy the tickets before enter in the transports.

By car: It takes about 45 minutes to 1 hour to travel from Porto to Aveiro using A1 or A29 highways.

*A29 and A17 (and other Portuguese highways) have electronic tolls exclusively. They are properly identified. More informations here: <<https://www.portugaltolls.com/en>>.

From Humberto Delgado airport (Lisbon) to Aveiro

By train: The best way to arrive in Aveiro from this airport is by metro and then by train. You should take the metro (red line) until the station “Oriente” (~10 min). There you should take a train to Aveiro (2-2:30 hours). You must buy the tickets before enter in the transports. You can buy the train tickets in advance here.

By car: It takes about 2 hours to travel from Lisbon to Aveiro using A1 or A8 and A17 highways.

*A29 and A17 (and other Portuguese highways) have electronic tolls exclusively. They are properly identified. More informations here.
